Let us confess our sin in the presence of God and of one another. Most merciful God,





SECOND READING: 2 Corinthians 4:13--5:1


A reading from 2 Corinthians.

GOSPEL: Mark 3:20-35

The holy gospel according to Mark. Glory to you, O Lord.

[Jesus went home;] ²⁰ and the crowd came together again, so that [Jesus and the disciples] could not even eat. ²¹When his family heard it, they went out to restrain him, for people were saying, "He has gone out of his mind." ²²And the scribes who came down from Jerusalem said, "He has Beelzebul, and by the ruler of the demons he casts out demons." ²³And he called them to him, and spoke to them in parables, "How can Satan cast out Satan? 24If a kingdom is divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand. ²⁵And if a house is divided against itself, that house will not be able to stand. ²⁶And if Satan has risen up against himself and is divided, he cannot stand, but his end has come. ²⁷But no one can enter a strong man's house and plunder his property without first tying up the strong man; then indeed the house can be plundered.




